How will your session be recorded and scored?

- Riders go onto the water with a phone in a waterproof pouch or an Apple Watch. They do not need to be connected to the internet with a sim card, but if they are connected, they will appear directly LIVE on the leaderboards. *Please note that to use a Watch a rider needs to be a (paid/subscribed) PRO user of the Surfr app*

- Waterproof Pouch can be borrowed from the organization to protect phone.
- The Surfr App is free, and the Pro version can be tried for a free period of two weeks.
- The Surfr App measures your jumps. In this competition, it is the HEIGHT that counts, but the other metrics are cool to know too.
- The average of your best 3 jumps count, that way we have a better chance getting the true champion of the Huts
- You can see the leaderboards in real time, as well as other details about their session.

How will we compete at the Huts?

- You will start with 6 people from the beach at the height of Armando's Kite Shack.
- Start the session on your phone/watch
- When the flag is raised in the judge tower and the signal has been sounded, you have 10 minutes on the water in between the buoys.
- After 10 minutes (Red Flag) you land your kite on the other side of the Event terrain (towards the shipwreck. (There will be a volunteer to help you land.)
- Stop the session.
- 2 minutes later the next heat starts.
- After 3 rounds the competitors for the finals on Sunday will be determined.
- The 4th round is the Final Round. The winners will come out of this round.
